## Sumner Men's Shelter

As of February 1, 2017 - the Sumner Emergency Shelter remains a 24/7 facility and able to host 160 single men, at capacity.

During daytime business hours, non-guests of IHS from the community are welcome to enjoy a free meal, use showers, and have access to mail and other support services as needed.

As of February 1, 2017 - the Kaaahi Women & Family Shelter remains a 24/7 facility and able to host 66 single women and 100 family individuals, at capacity.
