2024 PRIORITIES

Kūpuna / Supportive Services

- Increase in permanent supportive housing
- Funding for wrap-around supportive services at existing low-income/affordable housing sites
- Increased rent supplement for supportive housing

Behavioral Health

- Facilitate the Attorney General to submit Assisted Community Treatment (ACT) petitions by providing training to community case managers on initiating ACT petitions
- Improve data tracking of consumers subject to MH ER visits found eligible for ACT petitions
- Support base funding for Homeless Triage Center delivering medication-assisted detox

Community Re-Entry

- Expand and improve access to supportive services and transitional housing, decreasing recidivism and/or return to homelessness

ALICE Families

- Childcare tax credit
- Paid Family Leave
- Dependent Care tax credits (including kūpuna care)
